We welcome volunteers in or out of the state of Alabama. Volunteer needs range from: hands-on cemetery repair and clean-ups; locating and mapping; cemetery surveys; researching cemetery history profiles; newsletter contributions; registering cemeteries in the ACPA Cemetery Register; and assisting the County Reps, to name just a few. We also welcome experts in the field of restoration.

**What is an ACPA COUNTY REPRESENTATIVE?**

(ACPA County Representatives must be Alabama Residents, have Internet Access, and should live in or near the county they represent.)

ACPA County Representatives are dedicated volunteers physically located in or near each of the 67 counties of Alabama. Their presence on the county level is important in order to interface with: individuals; groups and organizations; businesses; state, city and county officials; law enforcement; and media to promote and seek participation in the ACPA's goals and mission. Because the ACPA County Representatives are volunteers, each approaches his/her position with their own personal experience and knowledge. They perform a variety of tasks, while observing the cemeteries within their county lines, in order to record their condition, confirm their locations, and provide current information on such issues as vandalism, theft, disputes and cemeteries in peril of being forever damaged or lost. They may also help to coordinate cemetery projects. The “County Reps” administer (with web master assistance) the ACPA County Representative Page (located within the ACPA web site) for their own county, and work as a network to respond to queries from the public on cemetery issues.
