

THE CHIEF TUSKALOOSA CHAPTER, DAR AND THE ALABAMA CEMETERY PRESERVATION ALLIANCE (ACPA) are pleased to announce a free Cemetery Preservation Workshop to clean and help preserve the gravesites of 5 Revolutionary War Soldiers interred in Tuscaloosa's historic Greenwood Cemetery. Work on other markers will be included as time permits. We will be led by world-class conservator JONATHAN APPELL OF ATLAS PRESERVATION based in Connecticut. This will be the Alabama venue of Jon's ambitious "48 States in 48 Days Tour" series of free cemetery preservation workshops. THE PROGRAM:

- 1. Jon will demonstrate approved cleaning techniques on one of the patriot markers with D/2 Biological Solution. Attendees will then split up in five groups to clean "their" assigned patriot marker. D/2 and other necessary materials will be provided.
- 2. Jon will demonstrate repairing a broken slab or tombstone. Attendees may be given a limited opportunity to repair broken slabs or tombstones with close supervision. Again, materials will be provided.
- 3. Panamerican Consultants will lift one table slab to see if a missing patriot's tombstone lies beneath.
- 4. Jon will demonstrate how to remove graffiti from stone.
- 5. Other demonstrations, instructional information and guided hands-on practice as time permits.

REQUIREMENTS TO ATTEND: Greenwood is a city-owned cemetery and the City requires all attendees to sign a release of liability form. The release form is attached. The City will accept typed signatures. Please complete the form and email to Becky Davenport at rgdaven9@gmail.com.

- 1. Cost: Free. Lunch selection and payment will be in advance and will be provided by Honeybaked Ham. Also, social distancing will be maintained and masks are mandatory. Recommend bringing a lawn chair, sun screen, drinking water, hat and gloves. The adjacent Van Hoose & Steel Funeral Services will make their restrooms available during the workshop. Parking will be on the back side of the cemetery; handicap parking will be near the main gate—see attached map.
